If you feel you have received a fraudulent call and are concerned about potential fraud on your account, please contact our Call Center immediately at (631) 698-7000.



- Charity Scams: Unfortunately, fraudsters are posing as charity staffers and asking for donations during these trying times. Before providing any information for payment, visit the charity's official website and contact them through their channels.
- Phishing Scams: Scammers have been posing as national organizations like The IRS, looking for personal financial information. You can verify calls by going straight to the source, like visiting official websites.
- Investment Scams: Fraudsters are creating websites to invest in false stocks. If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is. Always research traders before providing information or making any financial decisions.



- Using our Mobile Apps: Keep track of your transactions with the Teachers Mobile App and Card Valet where you can set up your cards for transaction notifications.
- Checking for Spelling: Verify emails and email addresses by looking for grammatical errors, and hover over links to determine where they are actually going.
